SECTION B Rules of Competition

B.6 Rifle Specifications

B.6.1 Light Class:

To be changed as follows:

Any centre fire rifle having a safe manually and mechanically operated firing mechanism and must not weigh more than 10 ½ pounds, inclusive of sights. The stock should have a flat or convex forearm not more than 3 inches wide.

The barrel would not be less than 18" **long forward of the bolt face and a diameter of not more than 1.250 inches from the bolt face forward 5 inches. From said 5-inch (diameter 1.25")point, the diameter would not be greater than would be defined by a straight taper between such point and a muzzle diameter of .900" at 29 inches.**

All other specifications are to be in accordance with Class Rifle Diagram; see Appendix A.

SECTION I Range Safety and Procedures

To add following paragraph:

I.4 Placing Bolt in An Action For Adjustment Purposes

Competitors may place a bolt in an action in the loading area providing the competitor:

- (a) Strips the bolt of the firing pin,**
- (b) Removes primer and powder from case,**
- (c) Shows bolt and case to neighbours, and**
- (d) Points muzzle in a safe direction.**

(e) Violators of this procedure will be disqualified.
